Education credits continue to be one of the most ever-changing credits. Currently there are two Education Credits for which one may qualify.

AOTC - American Opportunity Tax Credit NOTE: Must have 1098-T from education institution - per IRS

- > Can only be claimed for 4-years of higher education as an eligible student
- > Expenses paid must go toward education that results in an undergraduate or graduate degree or other recognized education credential at an eligible education institution
- Some of this credit may be refundable credit

LLC - Lifetime Learning Credit

NOTE: Must have 1098-T from education institution - per IRS

- > Has no limit on the number of years that one can claim as an eligible student
- > For expenses paid toward education that results in a degree (undergrad & grad) or other recognized education credential skills at an eligible education institution
- > LLC can also be for acquiring or improving job skills
- > None of this credit is refundable credit
- > One student, one credit though, more than one credit can be on the same tax return (*example*: Parent takes AOTC and dependent has LLC)
